The public is invited to an **Opening Reception on Sunday, September 27, from 1:30 to 4:30 p.m.**, where visitors will have the opportunity to meet many of the exhibiting artists and experience a remarkable collection of paintings, mixed media, and other original works inspired by cultures from around the world.

Returning alongside the exhibition is the popular **Prospect ArtistsMarket**, featuring local artists offering original artwork, pottery, jewelry, textiles, and handcrafted pieces for purchase. The ArtistsMarket will be held in the second-floor library on:
